*All the baptized are invited to the Lord's Table. Come forward as the ushers direct. Take an empty cup, receive the bread and wine, place the used cup in the basket by the side aisle, and return to your place by the side aisle. For those who cannot take wine, take a cup of grape juice from the silver tray. Lutherans believe that Christ is present in the Sacrament, and that through this gift, we receive forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation. **If you would like to receive communion, but are unable to come forward, please notify an usher, who will direct a server to bring the elements to you.***

## Children in Worship

At OSL, all ages are welcome and encouraged to be a part of the worship services. This welcome includes children and all that they bring with them – their energy, their need to move, their noise. A few things for parents to know:
